INTENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT*

Serves Hudson, Bergen, and Passaic Counties

Assists all Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolees (United 4 Ukraine) who are in need of more intensive case management and hands-on assistance.

REFUGEE SUPPORT SERVICES*

Serves Hudson, Bergen, and Passaic Counties

Assists all Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolees (United 4 Ukraine) after RCA and PC Gaps for up to 5 years.

UMCOR

Serves all of New Jersey

Assists conflict-affected Ukrainians who are not humanitarian parolees (TPS, Visa, etc.) in basic case management and referrals to resources, like food pantries, health clinics, etc.

REFUGEE CASH ASSISTANCE*

Serves Hudson, Bergen, and Passaic Counties

Helps eligible humanitarian immigrants by providing cash assistance for up to twelve months from their arrival date in the United States (or from the date of their immigration status for asylees or victims of trafficking).

For Single Adults and Married Couples without Children

HOUSING ASSISTANCE*

Serves Hudson, Bergen, and Passaic Counties

Assists enrolled CWS clients in finding temporary emergency housing and in how to find longer term housing.

EMPLOYMENT SERVICES*

Serves Hudson, Bergen, and Passaic Counties

Assists Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolees (United 4 Ukraine) enrolled in other CWS programs in job training, the job search process, interview preparation, and post-hire support.
