

## Are you a Uniting for Ukraine (U4U) supporter or beneficiary in New Jersey?

Ukrainians who were granted humanitarian parole status between February 24, 2022 and September 30, 2023 are eligible for the following benefits and services:

- Cash assistance
- Job training and job placement
- Help with emergency support, health, social services and other basic needs
- Help identifying daycare for your children and enrolling them in school
- After-school tutoring and enrichment for children
- English language classes for adults
- Mentoring for young adults
- Connections to mental health care and preventative health care
- Specialized services for the elderly
